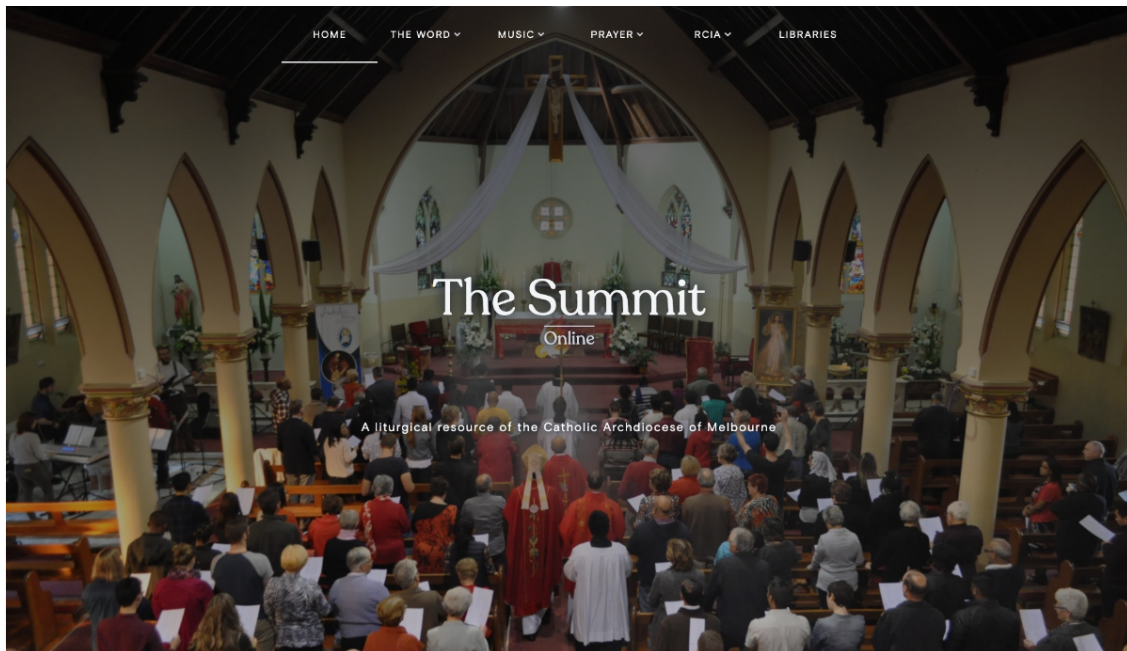

## A fresh new look for *The Summit Online*

In Advent, we eagerly await the new thing that God is doing among us—the coming of God’s reign in Jesus, Emmanuel, God with us. And of course, throughout the church year, in the liturgy—and especially in the Eucharist—we experience God with us in tangible and profound ways. It is especially fitting, then, that this Sunday, on the first day of Advent, and

at the start of a new liturgical year, we are launching the long-awaited and much-anticipated new *Summit Online* website.

## All your favourite features and more at the new *Summit Online*.

- **Weekly resources for liturgical teams.** Weekly readings and liturgy notes, prayers of the faithful, music suggestions and the 'Exploring the Word' resource for RCIA groups can all be viewed online, with easily downloadable files also available for 'Exploring the Word' and the prayers.
- **Articles from *The Summit's* rich archive** will be republished, gradually building an online trove of resources for the formation of liturgical ministers. The handy new search function will also help you find the articles and resources you most need.
- **'This Sunday' feature on the homepage**, where you can find the resources for the coming Sunday all in one place, including a link to the full text of the readings on *Universalis*. You can also jump to the resources for the following Sunday or access the next twelve weeks of a particular season.
- **Easy and intuitive site navigation** with multiple ways to access the resources you need, share and print them, with a simple menu bar and 'breadcrumbs' to help you find your way around.
- **Thematically organised 'libraries'**, where you will be directed to curated lists of excellent resources from around the web, as well as relevant *Summit* articles. This month, you will find libraries on Advent, music and prayer. We will also be publishing regular news items on liturgy-related events and developments.
- **An index of recommended music and hymns (to be launched in 2022)** to supplement the weekly suggestions. The index will be searchable by season, saint, part of the Mass, rite and topic, to help you find just the right piece of music.
